30 minutes (but we won't go that far)

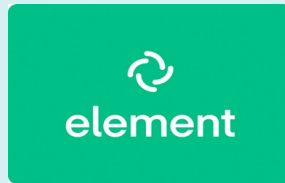

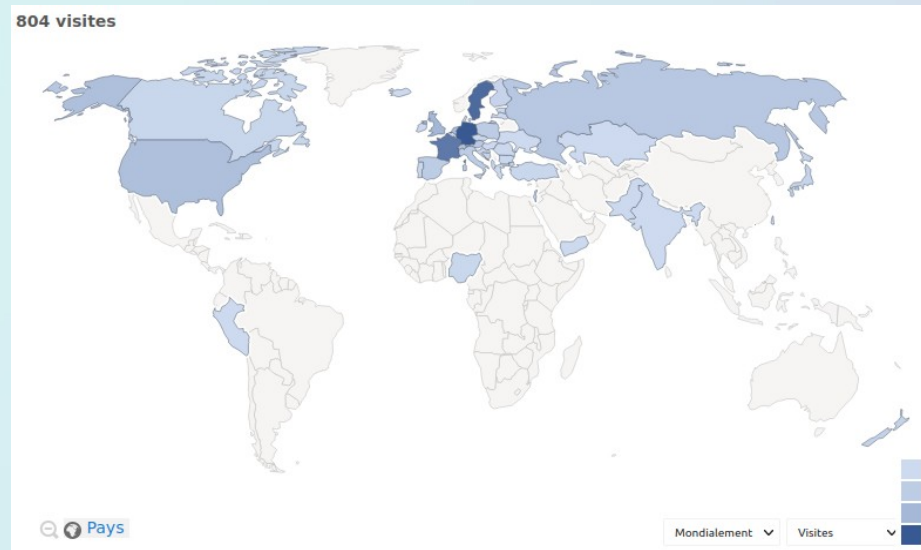
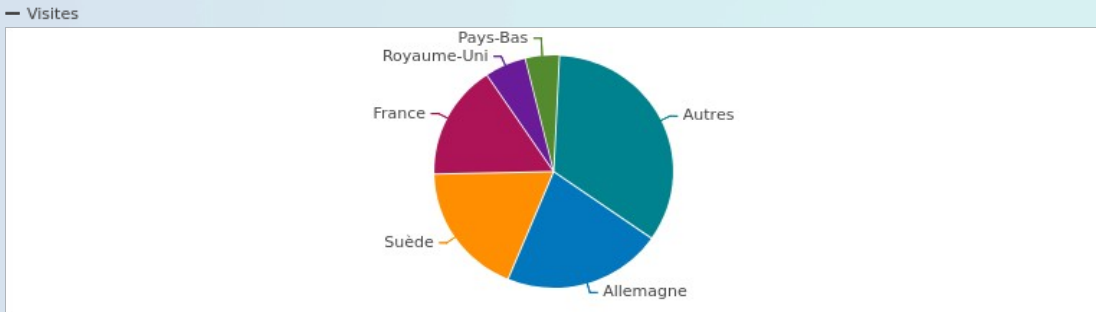
Event KPIs
